- The Governor Morehead School (GMS) campus is located at 301 Ashe Avenue in Raleigh, NC. We are adjacent to Pullen Park, The NC State University Campus, and Downtown Raleigh.
- **REGISTRATION** is on Saturday, July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017 starting at 9am in Crockett Peeler building (basement level).
- **CHECK OUT** is Saturday, August 5, 2017 starting at 1pm for those not attending the Talent Show hosted by the Governor Morehead School Alumni Association.
- **EARLY ARRIVAL OR LATE DEPARTURE** is available upon request. Contact Dr. Alan Chase, EYE Retreat Director for housing needs.
- In addition to The Governor Morehead School, the campus is home to the NC Rehabilitation Center for the Blind, Offices for the Division of Services for the Blind, The Governor Morehead Preschool, and Wake County School's Young Women's Leadership Academy. Please be mindful of their students, staff, and programs while you utilize the campus.
- Breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be provided each day by the campus dining services. Some days participants will be allowed to travel off campus for lunch and/or dinner (paid for by the EYE Retreat) to practice money management.
- A night monitor will be on duty in the cottages each night to ensure participant safety.
